i. Talk 1: Understanding the Shifting Distribution of Mammals in Lanjak Entimau Wildlife Sanctuary

A research team from the Smithsonian Institution, SARAWAK FORESTRY Corporation (including their Botanical Research Center), and local villages have been using camera traps and phenology surveys to document the response of large mammals to shifting fruit production in the forests of Lanjak Entimau Wildlife Sanctuary (LEWS).

ii. Talk 2: The Ecology of Molt: Why Avian Molt Matters

The scheduling of life-history activities in birds' lives remains a poorly understood aspect of ornithology. Though every species spends substantial time and energy replacing its feathers, molt scheduling and molt strategies, in particular, remain simply underappreciated. Indeed, to most, molt does not seem sexy; after all, it's not pretty either!
